Location: Campus, neighbourhood, city area, or any space with landmarks connected to historical figures

The Story

Statues, monuments and murals represent values, achievements, struggles, and stories that shaped the world. These stories often connect directly to Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs): equality, justice, education, peace, innovation, environmental protection, and cultural heritage.

Your mission: explore whose stories are visible in your community - and how these figures' legacies relate to the SDGs.

Let curiosity guide you to an SDG story hiding in plain sight.

Mission Tasks

Step 1: Pick Your Figure (5 minutes)

Walk around the area as a team and choose any statue, monument, or memorial that catches your attention.

Step 2: Investigate (10 minutes)

Use the information available on-site (names, plaques, symbols, inscriptions). Then do a quick online search to learn what this person did and why they are remembered. Take a clear photo of the statue.

Step 3: Connect to the SDGs (5 minutes)

Discuss which SDG(s) relate to this figure's work or values (e.g., education, equality, justice, innovation, peace, environmental protection). Choose 1–2 SDGs and explain your reasoning.

Step 4: Share Your Insight (5 minutes)

Prepare a short explanation: who the person is, what they contributed to society, which SDG(s) they connect to, and why their legacy matters today.

Optional mission bonus:

Share the photo with a short caption on social media.

Why Your Mission Matters

This activity helps you explore how cultural memory and public spaces shape our understanding of history. By linking historical achievements to the SDGs, you raise awareness of representation, gender equality, cultural heritage, and how individuals from the past contributed to goals we still strive for today.
