The Story

You are part of a newly formed team of Sustainability Detectives.

Your city looks normal - but beneath the surface, small everyday actions are quietly harming the environment and society.

Your mission: uncover hidden sustainability problems, document the evidence, and propose smarter, more sustainable solutions.

Mission Tasks

Step 1: Collect the Evidence (15 minutes)

Explore the area and find 5 examples of unsustainable practices, such as: excessive plastic use, food waste, wasted energy or water.

Take one photo of each example.

Step 2: Analyse Like a Detective (5 minutes)

Come back together as a team.

Choose 1-2 photos and discuss:

- What is happening here?
- Why is this a problem?
- What could be done differently?

Optional mission bonus:

Share one case on social media to raise awareness and inspire others to act.
