Time: 25 - 35 minutes

Teams: 3 - 6 players

Location: Urban space with discarded but safe materials

The Story

Europe produces enormous amounts of waste every year - hundreds of kilograms per person. Much of this waste becomes pollution instead of being reused, repaired, or recycled. Yet hidden in everyday rubbish are materials that can be transformed into something new and useful.

Your mission: find unwanted items in your surroundings and use them to create a simple, functional object.

Prove that creativity can give waste a second life.

Mission Tasks

Step 1: Explore Your Environment (5 minutes)

Search the nearby area (responsibly and safely) to find discarded items that can be reused. Examples include cardboard, containers, paper, broken objects, or plastic elements.

Step 2: Build Your Creation (15 minutes)

Using the materials you found, create one usable object. It can be practical, decorative, or problem-solving - the choice is yours. Let your creativity guide you.

Step 3: Demonstrate Your Object (5 minutes)

Bring your creation to a visible spot in the area and present it so that passers-by, or other members of the public can see it.

Explain what you made, how it works, and how reused materials helped reduce waste. If people are nearby, invite them to take a look or ask questions.
